## Lexington County Emergency Storm Debris Collection

---

In the aftermath of the Storm that passed through Lexington County, the County will be providing debris collection in your area. With this flyer, marking tape is included for you to mark the debris piles that you have placed at the curbside of your home to be sure that we do not collect valuable materials.

The following materials need to be placed separately near the curb:

**In one pile-**

- Wood and Yard Waste

**In a separate pile-**

- Furniture, carpet, carpet padding, glass windows, blinds, etc.
- Construction materials, wall board, siding, shingles, etc.
- Concrete/Asphalt

**In a separate pile-**

- Appliances, scrap metal

**In a separate pile-**

- Electronic waste, computers, televisions, printers, etc.

**Note: Please do not pile debris around hydrants, mailboxes, phone boxes, etc.**

**Please do not place household waste (garbage) or household hazardous waste in the piles at the curb.** If you have curbside waste collection, household waste can be placed out in the normal containers for collection. County Collection and Recycling Centers are available for household waste collection for those not using a curbside collection firm. **Collection Will begin on October 12**

**Note: Beginning Sunday night, October 11th, your assistance is requested to clear roadways of vehicles to allow equipment to operate in the area.**
