### **January 2012 - December 2012 Vehicle Registration Year**

The chart below can be used to determine if your vehicle would qualify for the optional high mileage.

**Cars and light trucks may appeal for high mileage. Light trucks must have a gross vehicle weight less than 11,000 pounds and a net vehicle weight less than 9,000 pounds to qualify for the high mileage deduction. All other vehicles will not qualify to appeal the assessment due to high mileage.**
