**FY08 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Application (Goals 1,3) - Sheriff's Department - Col. Allan Paavel** – Col. Paavel presented a request to apply for the FY08 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$18,999; no County match required. JAG program funds can go toward all components in the criminal justice system. The Magistrate Court Service and Sheriff's department will use their portion of the funds to purchase capital items. Sistercare will be providing counseling services for Lexington County and be reimbursed for a portion of their services.

A motion was made by Mr. Derrick, seconded by Mr. Kinard to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to apply for the FY08 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
