In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

**Coroner's Office Fees (Goal 3) - Coroner's Office - Harry Harman, Coroner** - Chief Deputy Coroner Brian Setree presented an outline of the proposed fee schedule for the Coroner's Office. Staff is recommending implementing charges for the following: coroner's report (\$20), autopsy report (\$150), toxicology report (\$50), and cremation permit (\$20). Families would not be charged. The fees would pertain only to those who stand to make a profit from these services. The projected revenue outlined for the FY2009/10 is estimated at \$27,080 and would supplement the General Fund to offset services provided by the Coroner's office.

A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Davis to recommend to full Council to approve staff's recommendations for the proposed fee schedule for the Coroner's Office.
