**Victims of Crime Act Grant Application - Sheriff's Department - Col. Allan Paavel** - Col. Paavel presented a request to apply for the Victims of Crime Act Grant in the amount of \$110,360. A County match of twenty percent in-kind cash of \$27,590 would be required. The grant application request is for a Criminal Domestic Violence (CDV) specialized victim's advocate officer as well as operating supplies, one vehicle, laptop, printer, digital camera, and filing cabinets.

A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Kinard to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to apply for the Victims of Crime Act Grant.
