**Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Application - Sheriff's Department - Colonel Allan Paavel -** Col. Paavel presented a request to apply for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant in the amount of \$4,000. There is a fifty percent local match required. The funds will be used to purchase body armor for officers.

A motion was made by Mr. Derrick, seconded by Mr. Keisler to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to apply for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant Application - Sheriff's Department - Colonel Allan Paavel -** Col. Paavel presented a request to apply for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant in the amount of \$31,850. There is no local match required. The funds will be used to purchase equipment to further improve the Sheriff's Crime Scene Investigation Laboratory.

A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Derrick to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to apply for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant.

The vote in favor was unanimous.
