Old Business - Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Grant Update - Ms. Hubbard reported after submitting the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant application the County has received a response that it would not be awarded the grant. Ms. Hubbard said the three-year grant totals almost \$940,000 and will be used to fund five resident deputies. She wanted to advise the Committee that the grant is still under consideration. There is no County match required. Staff will continue to monitor and return if the grant is awarded for the Committee's acceptance. For information only, no action taken.
