**Donation of Vehicles to Gaston Police Department - Sheriff's Department - Colonel Allan Paavel** - Col. Paavel presented a request from the Gaston Police Department for the donation of two dead-lined patrol vehicles. The Sheriff approved the request for one marked and one unmarked patrol vehicle. Fleet Services appraised the two vehicles at \$8,875 for fair market value. Staff is also requesting permission to transfer ownership of the vehicles to the Gaston Police Department.

A motion was made by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Keisler to recommend to full Council to approve the request from the Gaston Police Department for the donation of two dead-lined patrol vehicles and to transfer ownership.

The vote in favor was unanimous.
