The funds will be used for equipment and training in specific areas of the Incident Command System enhancing the Midlands Regional Type III IMT capabilities.

**FY 12 Law Enforcement Network (LEN) Grant Award (Goal 1) - Sheriff's Department - Col. Allan Paavel** - Col. Paavel presented a request to accept the FY 12 Law Enforcement Network (LEN) Grant award. The award is for \$28,000 with no County match required. The funds will be divided by the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit LEN Traffic Support Team at 75 percent (\$21,000) and the Host Agency at 25 percent (\$7,000) to be used to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the traffic enforcement units in all Lexington County municipalities.
