**FY 12 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Application (Goal 1) - Sheriff's Department - Col. Allan Paavel** - Col. Paavel presented a request to apply for the FY 12 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). The application amount is for \$39,035 with no County match required. The JAG funds will be allocated between Magistrate Court Services at \$4,684, Sheriff's Department at \$30,057 and Sistercare at \$4,294. Staff requested the application be presented to Council today due to the application deadline of May 14<sup>th</sup>.
