Zoning Map Amendment M06-15 - Old Chapin Road from Lexington Town Limits 260' North Towards Maxie Road and Maxie Road from the Intersection of Old Chapin Road 1000' North Towards Ashley Hills Drive - 2nd Reading – A motion was made by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Derrick to recommend to full Council to deny Zoning Map Amendment M06-15.
