

**PLANNING and ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES
JUNE 24, 2008**

The Planning and Administration Committee met on Tuesday, June 24, 2008 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 3:09 p.m. Mr. Jeffcoat, Committee Chairman presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Executive Session/Legal Briefing – A motion was made by Mr. Carrigg, seconded by Mr. Davis to go into Executive Session for a legal briefing.

The vote was in favor. Mr. Banning was not present when the vote was taken.

Mr. Jeffcoat reconvened the meeting in open session and reported there were no motions to be considered.

Zoning Text Amendment T08-05 - A Zoning Text Amendment to Amend the Lexington County Zoning Ordinance for the Purpose of Establishing Specific Exemptions to Section 24.10 - Noise - 2nd Reading - Planning & GIS - Charlie Compton, Director – Mr. Keisler reported that he had spoken with individuals about the Edmund Antique Tractor Pull event which has had issues with noise levels. The County will work with the event coordinators to meet all the requirements of the Noise Ordinance and allow the three events previously scheduled through November 8th, 2008. Zoning staff will check the noise level from the public address system at the next event scheduled for September 13, 2008. However, if they do not meet the requirements they will have to end the events.

A motion was made by Ms. Summers, seconded by Mr. Davis to recommend to full Council to deny the request of Zoning Text Amendment T08-05.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Old Business/New Business - Land Use Growth – None.
