

**PUBLIC WORKS & SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT  
COMMITTEE MINUTES  
OCTOBER 23, 2012**

The Public Works & Solid Waste Management Committee met on Tuesday, October 23, 2012 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 2:03 p.m. Mr. Cullum, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

**Kittal Road Closing - Public Works - Randy Edwards, P.E., County Engineer** - Mr. Edwards presented a request to close Kittal Road. The road is approximately 0.23 miles long. It is currently used as a cut-through from Pat Road to reach Edmund Highway by one individual. Mr. Edwards reported that it would cost approximately \$125,000 for design and construction to pave along with paving Jim Spence Road, including \$3,500 for realignment. Staff suggests closing Kittal Road to avoid these costs. Mr. Edwards said the Kittal Road property owner has been contacted and is in favor of closing the road. He confirmed Kittal Road was a county maintained dirt road. Mr. Mergo said if Council approves the closure, then we would direct staff to work out the prescriptive easement with our legal counsel.

A motion was made by Mr. Kinard, seconded by Mr. Jeffcoat to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to legally close Kittal Road.

**West Columbia Enhancement Grant Match Request - Public Works - Jim Starling, Engineering Associate III** - Mr. Starling presented a request from the City of West Columbia for enhancement grant match funds in the amount of \$36,250. The match funds are for the Sunset Boulevard and Jarvis Klapman Boulevard Beautification Project estimated at \$181,250. (The South Carolina Department of Transportation is funding 80 percent not to exceed \$145,000 with West Columbia's matching portion at \$36,250.) Staff reported funds are available in the Special Projects "Unclassified" account (#2700-121302-539900) which has a balance of \$41,125.

A motion was made by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Kinard to recommend to the County Transportation Committee (CTC) to approve West Columbia's enhancement grant reimbursement request.

Mr. Banning said that originally Council notified the School District they had to the end of September then to the end of October for the \$900,000 funding approved by Council. Mr. Cullum recommended if the County does not have the work from the School District by the next Council meeting on November 13 then the funds would be pulled.
