

**PUBLIC WORKS & SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

MARCH 26, 2013**

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

**Columbiana Drive (County Council District 7) Resurfacing Contract / Partnering with City of Columbia - Public Works - Wrenn Barrett, Director of Public Works -** Mr. Barrett presented a letter from the City of Columbia requesting to partner with the County in repairing/resurfacing approximately 300 feet of Columbiana Drive. The Richland County Transportation Committee (CTC) has approved \$860,000 for the project with the County's portion ranging from \$38,000 to \$43,000, depending on the final costs. The City of Columbia to design and manage the project. Staff recommends partnering with the City and approving up to \$43,000 of C-Funds for the County's portion of the project with approval from the County Transportation Committee (CTC). Currently there is \$913,000 in the C-Funds Road Resurfacing account (2700-121300-530001).

A motion was made by Mr. Matthews, seconded by Mr. Keisler to recommend to the CTC Committee to approve staff's recommendations to partner with the City and approve up to \$43,000 of C-Funds for the County's portion of the project.

**Old Business - S48 Update** - Mr. Barrett reported the S48 Project request for RFQ has been placed on the County Procurement's webpage which points them to the state's procurement publication, South Carolina Business Opportunity (SCBO).

**Old Business - Nursery Bridge Road Update** - Mr. Barrett reported the Nursery Bridge Road Project is going to be let sometime in May or June with a projected completion date of four-five months.

**Old Business - New Road/Corley Mill/Riverchase Monthly Update** - Mr. Jeffcoat reported he met with the Harmon family's attorney last week. The attorney was supposed to send a packet to the businesses leasing property along the right-of-way with an offer to buy their portion of the leased property. SCDOT is waiting on the County.

**Old Business - Active Construction Bond Update (Prior to FY13/14 Budget)** - Mr. Barrett said these would be brought to the Committee in June. He reported there has been no significant activity.

**Old Business/New Business - Flooding Issues/Kinley Creek Criteria; Stormwater Utility Fee; and Pine Glenn Alternate Exit (Emergency Access Road Cost)** - None.
