New Business - Bub Shumpert Road Update - Mr. Kinard reported Council approved a procedure for the top 25 roads scheduled to be paved that if any of the roads listed were having issues after two notification letters from Public Works then a public meeting would be scheduled. He said a public meeting was held for Bub Shumpert Road with approximately 50-60 people in attendance to provide information to property owners. It was noted that this is the start of 60-day period before Council's consideration to drop the road from the paving list. Mr. Kinard said his district was the first to undertake the new process.
