Old Business - New Road/Corley Mill/Riverchase Monthly Update - Mr. Cullum reported the Corley Mill/Highway 378 project is still in limbo. Mr. Banning said a right-of-way is needed for the Corley Mill roundabout for the next phase. Mr. Barrett reported the South

Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is not widening Highway 378 only striping the road and that right-of-way is needed before any widening can be done on Highway 378.
