The City of Columbia has developed a public service announcement (PSA) named Trash the Poop on the disposal of pet waste and stormwater runoff. USC arts students have been challenged to create a design for print campaign materials for Trash the Poop. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three winners. The Stormwater Division is funding \$150 towards the promotion with the funds coming from the Operating Supplies account as part of their education outreach program.
