In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Jesse's Way Bicycle Lane Dedication Along Blossom Street Bridge - Public Works - Jim Starling, Engineering Associate III - Mr. Starling presented a request for "C" funds from the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission for expenses occurred with a General Assembly resolution for the fabrication and placement of dedication signs. The General Assembly passed a resolution naming the bicycle lanes that cross the Congaree River along Blossom Street in Richland and Lexington counties to "Jesse's Way." Both counties are requested to contribute \$250 each.

A motion was made by Mr. Derrick, seconded by Mr. Banning to recommend to full Council to approve the request from the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission for "C" Funds for the "Jesse's Way" dedication signs.

The vote in favor was unanimous.
