

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
MINUTES
OCTOBER 25, 2011**

The Public Works Committee met on Tuesday, October 25, 2011 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 2:30 p.m. Mr. Cullum, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Meeting of September 27, 2011 - Approval of Minutes - A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Kinard to approve the September 27, 2011 minutes as submitted.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Old Business - South Congaree Sidewalk - Mr. Fechtel reported they were waiting on SCDOT for the encroachment permit.

Old Business - New Road/Corley Mill/Riverchase - Mr. Cullum said there was a scheduled meeting on Corley Mill and Highway 378 Intersection next week and will report back to the Committee with an update.

Old Business - Flooding - Mr. Cullum reported staff was still working on some of the flooding issues that are countywide by identifying and prioritizing those areas.

Old Business - Stormwater Land Development Manual - Mr. Cullum said he understood staff has received the preliminary review of the County's stormwater management permit. Mr. Fechtel said there were two permits under review and the MS4 Permit is still ongoing.

New Business - Hallmark Subdivision - Mr. Matthews said he would be attending a meeting on Tuesday on the Hallmark Subdivision with Mr. Randy Edwards of Public Works.

Old Business - Stormwater Utility - Mr. Cullum said staff was following up with the municipalities who missed the original meeting on the stormwater utilities fees by

coordinating a second meeting. Mr. Fechtel said some of the issues may be normal maintenance issues on state maintained roads. He plans to check with SCDOT on identifying those problem roads.

Old Business - Ben Kyzer - Mr. Fechtel reported staff was waiting on information from the individual requesting the closure of Ben Kyzer Drive. He said if they did not receive information then it would be brought back to full Council at the next meeting.

Old Business - Traffic Congestion, Alternate Material for Road Swells, Kinley Creek Criteria - None.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
