**Old Business - Traffic Congestion, Alternate Material for Road Swells, New Road - Corley Mill/Riverchase, Assessment of Ponds Inventory, Flooding Issues, Stormwater Land Development Manual Chapter 7** - Mr. Fechtel, Public Works Director, reported updates will be provided in the near future for the following items: alternate road situations for Corley Mill Road with feasibility study from SCDOT; traffic congestion funding issues; assessment of ponds inventory near complete; flooding is an ongoing issue, Stormwater Land Development Manual Chapter 7 pending meeting with Homeowners Association.

**New Business - Hollow Creek Watershed Stormwater Meeting** - Mr. Cullum briefed the Committee on a stormwater meeting he attended pertaining to the Hollow Creek Watershed.

**New Business - Aesthetics of Ponds** - Mr. Cullum expressed concerns about the aesthetics of ponds and how that fits into the Landscape Ordinance.
