

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
MINUTES
MAY 24, 2011**

The Public Works Committee met on Tuesday, May 24, 2011 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 3:15 p.m. Mr. Cullum, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Approval of Minutes - Meeting of April 12, 2011 - A motion was made by Mr. Kinard, seconded by Mr. Keisler to approve the April 12, 2011 minutes as submitted.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Old Business/New Business - Traffic Congestion, Alternate Material for Road Swells, New Road - Corley Mill/Riverchase, Flooding Issues - Kinley Creek Criteria, Stormwater Land Development Manual Chapter 7 - Mr. John Fechtel, Public Works Director, reported he had no news about the schools on Corley Mill but would follow up and return with an update. He said turn lanes were being put in on Corley Mill and improvements started at Mill Stream. Mr. Bruce Hiller, Community Development Administrator, reported the school district has agreed to abide by the new landscape and open space regulations. Mr. Fechtel said the school had committed to pave Frye Road. The Committee discussed their concerns about the School District's plans. Mr. Joe Mergo, County Deputy Administrator, pulled the South Carolina State Law Section 59-12-210 School Building Codes, Specifications, and Inspections that read: plans and specifications must be coordinated with county officials such as traffic engineers and zoning administrators. Mr. Cullum requested staff to forward a reminder to the School District about the statute.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
