

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 13, 2011**

The Public Works Committee met on Tuesday, September 13, 2011 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 2:02 p.m. Mr. Cullum, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

Approval of Minutes - Meeting of August 23, 2011 - A motion was made by Mr. Banning, seconded by Mr. Keisler to approve the August 23, 2011 minutes as submitted.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Old Business - Fox Branch Road - Mr. Fechtel provided the Fox Branch Road bid information for the 4:30 session.

Old Business - Corley Mill/Riverchase - Mr. Fechtel provided a map of a proposed route change for Corley Mill Road. He reported one of the options being considered is to close a portion of Corley Mill Road at River Chase to the light at Highway 378 and redirect traffic with a roundabout onto Dedrick Drive toward a new road and light onto Highway 378. This would be considered as Phase I. Phase II under consideration is to add additional lanes on Highway 378 by reducing the median and lanes without any additional construction cost. Mr. Fechtel said Lexington School District One is working to come up with a design. Mr. Cullum emphasized Council has not committed any funding for the Corley Mill Road/School/Highway 378 Road Project. There is a community meeting regarding the proposed relocation of Corley Mill Road scheduled at Zion Lutheran Church for Thursday, September 22.
