

**SOLID WASTE COMMITTEE  
MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 10, 2009**

The Solid Waste Committee met on Tuesday, November 10, 2009 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 2:25 p.m. Mr. Jeffcoat, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

**DHEC Used Oil Recycling Grant Award Supplement - Solid Waste Management - Dave Eger, Director** - Mr. Eger presented a request to accept the DHEC Used Oil Recycling Grant award supplement in the amount of \$39,378. There is no County match required. The funds will be used to maintain and improve used oil recycling in Lexington County.

A motion was made by Mr. Cullum, seconded by Ms. Summers to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to accept the DHEC Used Oil Recycling Grant Award Supplement.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

**PalmettoPride Community Pride Grant Application - Solid Waste Management - Dave Eger, Director** - Mr. Eger presented a request to apply for the PalmettoPride Community Pride Grant. There is no County match required. The amount requested is \$8,000 to be used to purchase recycling containers for Lexington County parks and sports complexes to begin recycling and provide a means to reduce litter.

A motion was made by Mr. Cullum, seconded by Mr. Davis to recommend to full Council to approve staff's request to apply for the PalmettoPride Community Pride Grant.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-04 - Carolina Materials Corp - 1<sup>st</sup> Reading - Solid Waste Management - Dave Eger, Director** - Mr. Eger presented the Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-04 for 1<sup>st</sup> Reading. Carolina Materials Corporation is requesting approval to expand their C&D landfill in the northeastern corner of their property of approximately 10.88 acres. The property is located at 120 Carl Drive in Lexington. Once

approved, the property owners will submit the request to DHEC for approval. The Lexington County Zoning office has approved the site plan. Public Hearing has been scheduled for December 8, 2009.

A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Cullum to recommend to full Council to approve 1<sup>st</sup> Reading for Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-04 - Carolina Materials Corp.

**Executive Session/Legal Briefing** - A motion was made by Mr. Davis, seconded by Mr. Cullum to go into Executive Session to obtain a legal opinion on Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-04.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Mr. Jeffcoat reconvened the meeting in open session with no motion to be considered.

**Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-05 - Platt Springs Scrap and Recycling - 1<sup>st</sup> Reading - Solid Waste Management - Dave Eger, Director** - Mr. Eger presented the Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-05 for 1<sup>st</sup> Reading. Platt Springs Scrap and Recycling is requesting approval to operate a metal recycling center on approximately 0.8 acres. The applicant plans to purchase small metal items from residents such as aluminum, copper, brass, stainless steel, lead, pot metal, and market the materials. They will not be accepting automobiles or large items at this location. The property is located at 5253 Platt Springs Road in Lexington. The Lexington County Zoning office has approved the site plan. Public Hearing has been scheduled for December 8, 2009. The Committee questioned the screening material currently being used by the property owner and what the screening requirements are for the facility.

The Committee agreed to delay 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-05 - Platt Springs Scrap and Recycling to allow Councilman Keisler an opportunity to review and meet with neighbors.
