Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-05 - Platt Springs Scrap and Recycling - 1st Reading - Solid Waste Management - Dave Eger - Director

Executive Session/Legal Briefing - A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Davis to go into Executive Session to discuss a Solid Waste matter.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Mr. Jeffcoat reconvened the meeting in open session with no motions to be considered.

Mr. Travis Batchler, the owner of Platt Springs Scrap and Recycling, was asked how he would avoid obtaining stolen property from individuals. He responded that he had inquired with another scrap business owner on this issue and the owner told him he photocopies driver's licenses and takes the names and addresses of the individual selling the items. This deters individuals who may be trying to sell him stolen property. Mr. Batchler said he would be putting this same practice in place for his business. The Committee asked if there were any regulations in place for recycling metals that require taking in certain data of those individuals that bring in the metals. Mr. Batchler responded that he did not know of any such regulations. He said his business will only be buying and storing for a short period of time, then selling to larger

companies for the actual recycling. No processing will be done at this facility.

A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Davis to recommend to full Council to approve the 1st Reading of Solid Waste Processing Facility Application 09-05.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

Approval of Minutes - Meeting of November 10, 2009 - A motion was made by Mr. Keisler, seconded by Mr. Cullum to approve the November 10, 2009 minutes as submitted.

The vote was in favor. Mr. Davis did not vote.
