

**SOLID WASTE COMMITTEE  
MINUTES  
JUNE 14, 2011**

The Solid Waste Committee met on Tuesday, June 14, 2011 in the Committee Room, located on the second floor of the Administration Building beginning at 2:18 p.m. Ms. Summers, Committee Chairman, presided.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of the agenda was sent to radio and TV stations, newspapers, and posted on the bulletin board located in the lobby of the County Administration Building.

**Solid Waste/Processing Facility Application #11-01 - First Reading - Solid Waste**

**Management - Dave Eger, Director** - Mr. Eger presented Solid Waste/Processing Facility Application #SW11-01 for first reading. The application was submitted by Tristar Land Company, LLC and LLN Properties Incorporated. Mr. Eger provided a map of the facility in relationship to the other woodwaste processing facilities in the County and, as requested, within a 5-mile radius of the Tristar facility. Mr. Eger also provided handouts with additional information, as requested by the Committee, containing recycling and processing activities, used oil and/or processing facilities, plus a list of the company principals. He invited members of the development and engineering firm to be present if there were any questions. Mr. Eger said there are no restrictions on the number of recycling facilities for the County. The Committee discussed the number of woodwaste processing facilities in the area and the different materials processed by each facility.

A motion was made by Mr. Cullum, seconded by Mr. Jeffcoat to recommend to full Council to approve first Reading of Solid Waste/Processing Facility Application #11-01.

The Committee asked if Zoning was favorable for this type of business facility and the response was yes.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Approval of Minutes - Meeting of May 24, 2011** - A motion was made by Mr. Cullum, seconded by Mr. Davis to approve the May 24, 2011 minutes as submitted.

The vote in favor was unanimous.

**Old Business - Mandatory Curbside Pickup Pilot Program** - Ms. Summers asked about the status of the mandatory curbside pickup pilot program. Mr. Eger reported Council had decided they would discuss it when it reached 75 percent before considering going forward with a pilot program. He said the Irmo area was at 74 percent before the collections areas were changed. The Committee asked staff to stay on top of the numbers and report back if there are any changes especially after the redistricting is complete.

**New Business** - None.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
