

GUIDELINES

Theme:

The quality of the air we breathe is important to our health. Our everyday activities can have a huge impact on the quality of our air. We can make simple and important changes to our daily activities in order to improve air quality. Students are challenged to creatively illustrate activities that they can adopt in their daily lives that will help keep our air clean!

Contest Rules:

1. Students are encouraged to use the “SPARE THE AIR” slogan in their picture. Drawings must focus on a *positive* aspect of air quality (i.e. not the pollution itself but the actions needed to reduce air pollution). All artwork must be original artwork. Copying materials from existing artwork will not be accepted.
2. Drawings must be done on 8.5 x 11 paper. Use the Landscape layout for page orientation.
3. The contest is open to 5th – 7th grade students, from public, private and home schools in Lexington County. One entry per student.
4. Drawings submitted become the property of Lexington County Stormwater Division and will not be returned and may be used in association with this contest for publication in print or on the internet.
5. Drawings must be submitted with a completed entry form for each student attached to the back of the drawing along with the teacher evaluation form (one per teacher).
