(non-commercial events)

## Electronic Recycling Guidelines

- Acceptable Items (computers & accessories, monitors, printers, DVD players, fax machines, gaming systems, phones, stereo equipment, TVs, VCRs and more) - **8 item limit**
- Unaccepted items (dismantled computers and TVs, loose batteries, fluorescent bulbs, liquid gas, lava lamps, air condition units, refrigerators, scrap metal, smoke detectors, and more)

## Household Hazardous Waste Guidelines (HHW)

- Acceptable Items (8 gallon limit on liquids)
  - Acid/Base waste
  - Caustic/Corrosives
  - Gas Cylinders/Tanks (propane-5gal & camp style disposable, compressed gas cylinders – check with gas distributor for returnability)
  - Fire extinguishers
  - Fluorescent light bulbs/tubes
  - Household products (aerosols, batteries, cleaners, wax)
  - Insecticides/herbicides/fertilizer
  - Mercury and heavy metal products (mercury thermostats/thermometers, etc)
  - Paints and stains (latex and oil-based stains, solvents, paint thinners, wood stains)
  - PCB ballasts
  - Pool and spa chemicals
- Unaccepted
  - Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
  - Asbestos containing material
  - Commercial hazardous waste
  - Contaminated soil
  - Empty containers
  - Extremely hazardous waste over 2.2 lbs
  - Laboratory chemicals w/o prior approval
  - Medical sharps (other medical waste)
  - Nitric Acid over 75% strength
  - Nonhazardous waste
  - Oversized batteries
  - Peroxide over 60% strength
  - Pharmaceuticals
  - Pyrophoric Materials
  - Radioactive material

**Reminder:** Car batteries, fluorescent light bulbs/tubes, cooking oil, used oil, antifreeze, gasoline mixtures, and scrap metal is accepted at all Collection and Recycle Centers. Tires are accepted at selected Collection and Recycle Centers and the Edmund Landfill. See the Lexington County Recycle brochure for more information.
