



Lexington County Residents:

The following changes to the Ball Park Road Collection and Recycling Center are being made to improve the traffic flow and reduce vehicle backups on Ball Park Road:

- **TRAFFIC PATTERNS: Beginning on Wednesday, September 4, 2013, the entrance and exit gates at this facility will be reversed.** The new traffic pattern will require vehicles to enter the facility through the old exit gate and exit through the old entrance gate (see directory and directional arrows). Reversing the traffic flow, will reduce the number of stopped vehicles on Ball Park Road by providing a larger stacking area on the facility.
- **ADDITIONAL COMPACTOR:** A clean wood waste compactor will be added to eliminate the 30yd open top containers currently being used onsite. The compactor will be placed alongside the yard compactors. The additional compactor will alleviate traffic congestion around the household containers and be much easier for citizens to dispose of their clean wood waste.

Below, you will find a directory detailing the location of receptacles for each commodity that is accepted at the Collection and Recycling Center.

The changes to the Center will provide for a safer and more efficient environment. The facility is designed to allow for the drop off of recyclable materials and then household trash. Residents with only yard debris will be able to bypass these areas.
