Improperly disposed of tires can harm the environment and cause potential health risks, so they must be recycled.

Lexington County residents may take old tires to the Edmund Landfill or to Lexington County Collection & Recycling Centers at Ball Park, Bush River, Chapin, Sandhills, Southeast and Summit locations (Centers are limited to four non-commercial tires per day per household).
