Main Street, Lexington, South Carolina at 9:30 A.M., Friday, April 11, 2014. Attorneys should check with the security staff when entering the courthouse for the location of the roster meeting. Courtroom assignments will be made at a later date.

**ALL ATTORNEYS SHOULD MAKE SURE THAT PRO SE PARTIES AND PARTIES IN DEFAULT ARE PROPERLY NOTIFIED OF THE HEARING.**

**CONTINUANCES**

Chief Justice Toal has directed that a request for a continuance is a motion requiring payment of the \$25.00 filing fee. Request for continuance should be in writing, filed well in advance with the Clerk of Court, with a copy sent to opposing counsel/pro se party, and to the Honorable Thomas A. Russo, Chief Judge for Administrative Purposes. Absent extraordinary circumstances, request for continuance received by Judge Russo's office after 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday preceding a term may not be handled in advance and must be raised to the Presiding Judge in Court.
