VIOLATION COMPLAINT GUIDELINES

Thank you for submitting your complaint. It will be forwarded to our Community Development Department, where staff will review it for compliance. Code complaints are investigated in the order they are received. If a violation is found, the property owner is typically issued a 30-day notice to comply. However, each case is evaluated individually, and deadlines may vary depending on the circumstances. If progress toward compliance is evident, extensions may be granted. Due to the high volume of complaints and the need for staff to conduct field

inspections, updates may not be immediate, but we will provide them as soon as possible.

If the property complies with Lexington County Ordinances, the case will be closed. If there is no response after the initial deadline, the matter will be referred to the Lexington County Sheriff's Department Code Enforcement Division. It is then up to the responding officer to determine whether to issue a citation, summons, or grant additional time for compliance.

Please allow 15–20 business days for your complaint to be reviewed and investigated. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to resolve issues across Lexington County.
