

Items Needed For Variance

1. Fill out the Planning Commission Variance Application.

2. Create a letter to Planning Commission explaining why you would like to seek your variance, what it is, any necessary information that you think is pertinent to your case, etc.

3. Create a separate document showing the Standards for a Variance. You will need to type each one of the items (a-e) listed below and provide a response to each one. Just a few sentences to show how you are meeting each one of these standards for a Variance. This is where you prove the validity of your case before Planning Commission.

a. There are extraordinary and exceptional conditions pertaining to the property or properties.

b. These conditions do not generally apply to other properties in the vicinity.

c. Because of these conditions, the application of this Ordinance to the particular property or properties would effectively prohibit or unreasonably restrict the utilization of the property or properties.

d. The authorization of this variance would not be a substantial detriment to adjacent property or the quality of life for the residents of the County.

e. When deliberating a variance request, financial hardships, alone, cannot be considered for the basis of a variance.

4. If your proposed access or road is over property owned by another, you must provide written proof of their consent to the variance request.

5. A plat or sketch of your proposed subdivision of property.

6. All submittals require a Subdivision Variance Request fee in the amount of \$136.00 payable to the County of Lexington.
